

High School Report: NM's Anderson Throws First No-Hitter

North Mason sophomore Emily Anderson proved she's not the only solid pitcher on the Bulldogs' Class 2A state champion team.

Anderson threw her first career no-hitter against the Port Townsend Redskins, earning a 10-0, six-inning win Friday in Olympic League fastpitch action.

Anderson struck out 13 batters and didn't issue a walk. NM improved to 9-3 overall (8-2 league) while the Redskins fell to 2-7 (1-6).
